## Progress Report on SDG 9

Industry, Innovation and Infrastructure at Rajshahi University of Engineering & Technology (RUET)

Rajshahi University of Engineering & Technology (RUET) is committed to fostering resilient infrastructure, promoting inclusive and sustainable industrialisation, and supporting innovation, fully aligned with **Sustainable Development Goal 9**. Through campus infrastructure expansion, industry-academia collaborations, and innovation initiatives, RUET serves as a national hub for technological advancement and industrial capacity-building.

### **Key Highlights**

- Campus Infrastructure Development:
  - RUET is implementing a TK 599.30 crore (~USD 57 million) infrastructure project, including 11 new 10-storey buildings for Mechanical, Electrical & Computer, and Civil Engineering departments, dormitories, staff quarters, and a new medical centre. As of March 2025, 70 % of construction was completed. (BSS News)

#### • Innovation & Research Institutes:

- The Institute of Information and Communication Technology (IICT), established in 2016, focuses on developing knowledge-based products and services, innovation projects, and industry consulting. (IICT-RUET)
- RUET's Research & Innovation Office facilitates applied research, consultancy, and technology transfer that support industrial and societal development. (<u>URP-RUET</u>)

#### • Industry-Academia Collaboration:

- 1st Industry-Academia Collaboration Meet (IACM-2023): MoUs signed with Huawei, BJIT, Datasoft, Shanghai BDCOM, RajIT, and Innovative Engineering & Development (IED), attended by ~150 industry executives.

- Partnership with Huawei Technologies Bangladesh (2022) to establish an ICT Academy at RUET, strengthening ICT infrastructure, training, and student industry-readiness. (<u>The Daily Star</u>)
- MoU with National Skill Development Authority (NSDA, 2025) to deliver short courses, competency-based curricula, and global job-market

preparation. (RUET)

 MoU with Bangladesh Institute of Management (BIM, 2025) for sharing infrastructure, faculty, and academic programs. (IICT-RUET)

#### • Innovation Hub & Entrepreneurship:

- University Innovation Hub (UIH) Project: 5,400+ sq ft space funded at BDT 11,894,428.445 for incubation, prototyping, and entrepreneurship activities. (Bangla CPTU)
- Innovation Hub Competition (May 2024): Team Visionary Velocity (MTE '20 & BECM '20) won for startup Anondopath, among 12 competing teams.
  (CME-RUET)
- University Innovation Hub mentorship program (Nov 2024) trained 20 participants including faculty and student entrepreneurs. (<u>UIHP</u>)

#### **Impact & Next Steps**

RUET's infrastructure projects, innovation-focused institutes, and industry collaborations advance SDG 9 targets: building high-quality, sustainable infrastructure, promoting inclusive industrialisation, and enhancing access to research and innovation.

#### Planned improvements include:

- Publishing **quantitative innovation metrics**: number of patents filed, start-ups launched, industry-funded research projects, and infrastructure utilization statistics.
- Expanding **cross-disciplinary infrastructure**: labs, prototype workshops, and testing facilities to support student start-ups and industrial partners.
- Enhancing regional industrial linkages, establishing research-industry clusters, technology transfer offices, and incubation programs in northern Bangladesh.
- Scaling the **Innovation Hub** to annually support ~500 male and ~250 female students with mentoring, prototyping, and entrepreneurship training.
